A complex tax system is one of many considerations; potential jurors may come into the case with complicated experiences and views of the IRS and the U.S. tax system, Sweeney explains. For example, although jurors may view the IRS negatively and loathe reporting and paying taxes, that doesnt necessarily mean they will sympathize with a defendant who didnt report all income or pay all taxes when they had to do those things themselves.
