A Project 2025 target: The IRS, Tax Notes

Rettig Contributes to Tax Notes Article

In an article published in Tax Notes on July 23, 2024, and included in Politico's Weekly Tax newsletter on July 29, 2024, Former IRS Commissioner and Shareholder and Shareholder Chuck Rettig's insight was included on the conversation around this year's election, specifically on political influence on the IRS.
