With a wide-ranging practice focused on complex commercial litigation, Blair represents both individuals and corporations in litigation and investigatory matters frequently touching on large-scale transactions and the financial services industry. She dedicates significant time to *pro bono* matters, and is the firm’s corporate representative to the NYC nonprofit Her Justice.
