Anti-Asian violence has been on the rise nationwide, with New York City recording the highest number of anti-Asian incidents in the U.S. Reported hate crimes against Asian New Yorkers have increased by 400% in 2021 compared to the same time frame in 2020. Sadly, many more incidents go unreported.

In keeping with an ongoing commitment to fight racism, the Asian Equality Taskforce at Holwell Shuster & Goldberg aims to raise awareness and implement initiatives to show solidarity and support for all members of our community who are experiencing racist backlash in the current climate.
