Employee Benefit Basics for Business Attorneys

Benjamin L. Grosz served as chair and moderator of the ABA "Business Law Basics" CLE program. Ben was joined on the panel by Ivins partner Steven H. Witmer, as well as in-house counsel co-panelists Anne K. Kyzmir (*Asst. General Counsel, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corp.*) and David L. Pilson (*Director, Compensation & Benefits Counsel, eBay Inc.*).
