St. L. Rev. 513, 565 n. 355 (2018), in support of the proposition that the D.C. Circuit decision in this case "may be inconsistent with the new narrower reading" of the Anti-Injunction Act, based on the Supreme Court's 2015 decision in *Direct Marketing Association v. Brohl*.
