

## Glenn Weinstein Wins NABL Carlson Prize

Weinstein is one of four co-authors of the winning article, "Practical Considerations in Electronic Disclosure by State and Municipal Bond Issuers," which was published in the Fall 2019 edition of the *Municipal Finance Journal* and the Spring 2020 edition of *The Bond Lawyer*.
