Traison (Chicago & Detroit offices) recently spoke to the European Group of the International Women Associates in Chicago for the program, "Poland in the Heart of the Jews and the Jews in the Heart of Poland: why we love to hate each other." The two-hour presentation covered the history of Poland, with specific focus on the 19th and 20th centuries, and included an extensive and engaging question and answer period among the 50 mostly European participants and Traison.
