**From I-94:** Take 10 (Lodge) South to Jefferson East. Turn right on Randolph and right again into the Windsor/Detroit Tunnel. After clearing Customs, proceed to Park Street. Turn left on Park.

Turn right at first traffic light (Ouellette Avenue) and travel north to Riverside Drive. The office is located on the 13th floor of the building at the northeast corner of Ouellette Avenue and Riverside Drive.

**From M-14:** Take I-96 to 10 South/Civic Center to Jefferson Avenue East. Turn right on Randolph and right again into the Windsor/Detroit Tunnel. After clearing Customs, proceed to Park Street. Turn left on Park.

Turn right at first traffic light (Ouellette Avenue) and travel north to Riverside Drive. The office is located on the 13th floor of the building at the northeast corner of Ouellette Avenue and Riverside Drive.
