

Proposed State Regulation Would Allow Cannabis Deliveries in All Jurisdictions

The State Bureau of Cannabis Control ("Bureau") has just released proposed regulations implementing and interpreting the Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act.

The proposal includes a regulation that would allow cannabis deliveries in all jurisdictions. Draft Regulation 5416 reads: "a delivery employee may deliver to any jurisdiction within the State of California." If this regulation goes into effect, cities and counties could not enforce ordinances that prohibit delivery of cannabis to property within the city or county's territory.
