Deedee Bitran, an attorney in Shutts & Bowen LLP's Fort Lauderdale office, was recently a featured panelist during a breast cancer awareness event put on by the Miami Cancer Institute and Yodeah, as well as breast oncology surgeon, Dr. Starr Mautner.

The event sought to educate attendees on breast cancer, treatment, prevention, prophylactic surgeries, and genetic testing. During the event, Deedee discussed her own journey with the BRCA gene and a prophylactic bilateral mastectomy, taking her risk of breast cancer from close to 75 percent to under 5 percent.
