

Gov. DeSantis Appoints Ashley Hodson to Florida Judicial Nominating Commission

Governor Ron DeSantis announced yesterday two appointments to Florida's Judicial Nominating Commissions (JNCs), including Ashley S. Hodson, a partner in Shutts & Bowen LLP's Sarasota office.

Each of the 27 separate, nonpartisan JNCs consist of nine members appointed by the governor, four of which are lawyers. Each member is responsible for evaluating candidates and drafting a list of nominees when vacancies open on the benches of Florida's judicial system. Governor DeSantis appointed Ashley to the Twelfth Circuit Judicial Nominating Commission, which covers DeSoto, Manatee and Sarasota counties. She is appointed for a term ending July 1, 2023.
