On Thursday, September 28, Tampa partner James Terpening presented before in-house counsel members of the Association of Corporate Counsel (ACC)'s Real Estate Network (REN). Jimmy, who is Florida Bar Board Certified in Construction Law, presented on the topic of contractual indemnity.

He provided guidance on how best to pursue or defend these claims in court, as well as how to potentially avoid litigation through effective transactional drafting and pre-suit negotiations.
