The Committee is responsible for leading a nationwide search for FIU's next president, ensuring the process is transparent, effective, and aligned with state laws and the priorities of the Board of Governors and FIU. Key duties include developing position criteria, approving a marketing plan, identifying and vetting candidates, and recommending finalists to the Board of Trustees.
