

Ricky Polston Speaks at Florida State University's Spring Commencement Ceremony

Ricky Polston, a partner in the Tallahassee office of Shutts & Bowen LLP and Chair of the firm's Constitutional Law Section, recently spoke at Florida State University's Commencement Ceremony on May 3, 2025.

Ricky, who is a former Florida Supreme Court Chief Justice, addressed graduates from the FAMU-FSU College of Engineering and the College of Nursing, as well as the Anne Spencer Daves College of Education, Health, and Human Sciences.

Ricky is a double graduate of Florida State University, earning his bachelor's degree in Accounting, as well as his Juris Doctor from the university. He also served as an adjunct professor at FSU College of Law for 20 years, teaching various courses including Insurance Law, Florida Constitutional Law, Florida Alternative Dispute Resolution (substantive law on federal and Florida arbitration and mediation), Appellate Practice (clinical), and Accounting for Lawyers.
