During their presentation, Tirso and Ella explored how artificial intelligence is reshaping real estate transactions and litigation support, emphasizing the importance of working smarter while maintaining professional standards. They discussed the increasing need to vet Al tools carefully, referencing recent cases which highlight the consequences of relying on unverified Al-generated content. The presenters reviewed several widely used tools, illustrating how these platforms can streamline research, document review, drafting, analysis, e-discovery, and other tasks when properly supervised by trained attorneys.

They also discussed key considerations when selecting or implementing AI tools, including reliability, accuracy, and the extent to which a firm can trust an AI system without compromising quality or exposing itself or its clients to liability. While AI can assist with many tasks, Tirso and Ella emphasized that human verification by qualified professionals remains essential.
