Miami partner and [Cuba Task Force](#) Chair [Aliette DelPozo Rodz](#) will speak at the [Cuban American Bar Association's \(CABA\) Cuba Conference](#) on Friday, September 23 at 3:15 pm at the [Florida International University College of Law](#). The 90-minute panel discussion will address foreign investment in Cuba, with an emphasis on legal, economic and structural issues affecting foreign investors.

The two-day conference, which runs from September 23 through September 24 will address a variety of topics including political, legal and economic conditions on the island.
