

Gary Bagliebter Selected to City of Hollywood's Charter Review Committee

Gary M. Bagliebter, a partner in Shutts & Bowen's Fort Lauderdale Litigation Department, was recently selected by the City of Hollywood Commission as one of eleven people who will serve as the City's Charter Review Committee, and was elected Chairman by the Committee's members.
