The presentation provided an update on government relief programs targeted to the hospitality industry as well as new rules and regulations addressing labor and employment issues.

The topics included CARES Act implications for the hotel/hospitality industry; information about the CARES Act loan programs, eligibility requirements and application process; new provisions relating to sick leave and caretaker leave; and basic takeaways from updates to the Families First Coronavirus Response Act, including paid leave entitlements.
