Throughout the month of January, the team at Shutts & Bowen's Fort Lauderdale office will volunteer to staff the Legal Aid Service of Broward County's "Telephone Advice and Counsel Hotline." This service offers free legal advice and counsel to low-income residents of Broward County and is staffed by volunteer attorneys from the community. The areas of law in which they offer assistance include private landlord/tenant, consumer and some family law matters.
